Summer uniform is worn in Terms 1 and 4 and Winter uniform in Terms 2 and 3.

Sports uniform is worn on days and for events designated by class teachers. All clothing and personal belongings must be clearly marked with your name.

Jewellery

Students in Years R- 4 are permitted to wear a watch and one pair of silver or gold plain sleepers or studs for pierced ears.

Children in Years 5-6 are permitted to wear a watch, one pair of silver or gold plain sleepers/studs for pierced ears. Children may add a simple chain with a religious medallion and one signet ring.

Nail Polish and Make Up

Nail polish and make up is not permitted at school.

Hair

Hair that is longer than shoulder length must be neatly and securely tied back. Ribbons, headbands or hair-ties must be in school colours or summer and winter uniform fabric. Extreme hair styles, colours or bleaches are not permitted at school.

The wearing of the school uniform is compulsory. This is a policy of the school and is endorsed by Dominican School Board. If students are out of uniform, a note be given to the classroom teacher as to the reason why this has occurred. When a child is out of school uniform without a note the class teacher will have a conversation with the child. Any further issues with the wearing of uniform will be discussed with the student's parents. Students consistently out of uniform will be referred to the Leadership Team.
