Dear Families,

I hope your children are very excited about this up-and-coming December and January School holiday program.

Our OSHC Staff Team during the October holidays consists of Janine, Scott, Nichola, Natasha, Sarah, Nick, Georgia, Hannah, Katy, Mitchell and Ashleigh.

Here are a few details of the program and times of leaving for excursions and what to bring and what not to bring.

- Food Each day you need to pack for your child a healthy recess and lunch. We provide afternoon tea each day. Just like school, nude foods would be amazing! Please also pack a water bottle.
- If you are booked into Friday 20th December, lunch is provided, but you will still need to bring a healthy snack for recess.
- Clothing please wear comfortable clothing, no crocs or thongs or singlets.
 Please wear clothing suitable to each day's weather forecasts.
- o Sunscreen is provided daily. If you believe your child has an allergy, you can bring in your labelled sunscreen for your child on the day.
- Hats We provide every child with a hat. They are kept on the premises.

LATE PICK-UP FEES

If a parent/guardian fails to pick up their child by the advertised closing time, the parent/guardian will be charged a late fee. This fee is to cover the additional costs of keeping the service open beyond the closing time of the service. There shall be a minimum of two educators always present at the service. An educator with all required qualifications will remain at the service until the last child has been picked up.

LATE PICK-UP PROCEDURES

If the registered child is not collected from the Service by the advertised closing time, there will be a \$10 every 5 minutes per child fee. Parents/Guardians are given clear notification that they should inform the Service if they know they will be late. If this situation occurs more than three times in a program, the remainder of the bookings may be cancelled.

OVERDUE FEES

Dominican School OSHC encourages Parents/Caregivers to contact Dominican OSHC to discuss any difficulties they may have in making payments and to make suitable arrangements to pay, including the option of a payment plan.
